

High Road to Earl Sterndale

Time: 1¼ hours approx.

Distance: 5.5 kms (3.5 miles)

Walk down the drive past Sheldon Cottage.
At the end of the drive turn right and then follow the lane
opposite heading uphill along the stone wall **(A)**.

Follow the lane up and then down until you reach a gravel path
on your left, marked 'Cycle Route 68' **(B)**.

Go through the gate and after 150 meters,
take the footpath marked to the left.

Cross the field bearing slightly uphill,
ending up in the right hand corner of the field **(C)**.

Cross the stile ahead and continue on the path
keeping the quarry on your right and passing through a gate.

When you reach a stony track **(D)**, bear left
down the hill, and pass through a metal gate.
Then take the 1st track on your right **(E)**.

When you reach the road, turn left and descend down
past the Village School and Church to the village green.

If it's open, have a drink at the Quiet Woman Pub.

With the pub behind you, turn right and take the road past
the Methodist Chapel.

Just before the village pond on your right, take the left fork,
marked with a brown 'i' sign, direction Hartington **(F)**.

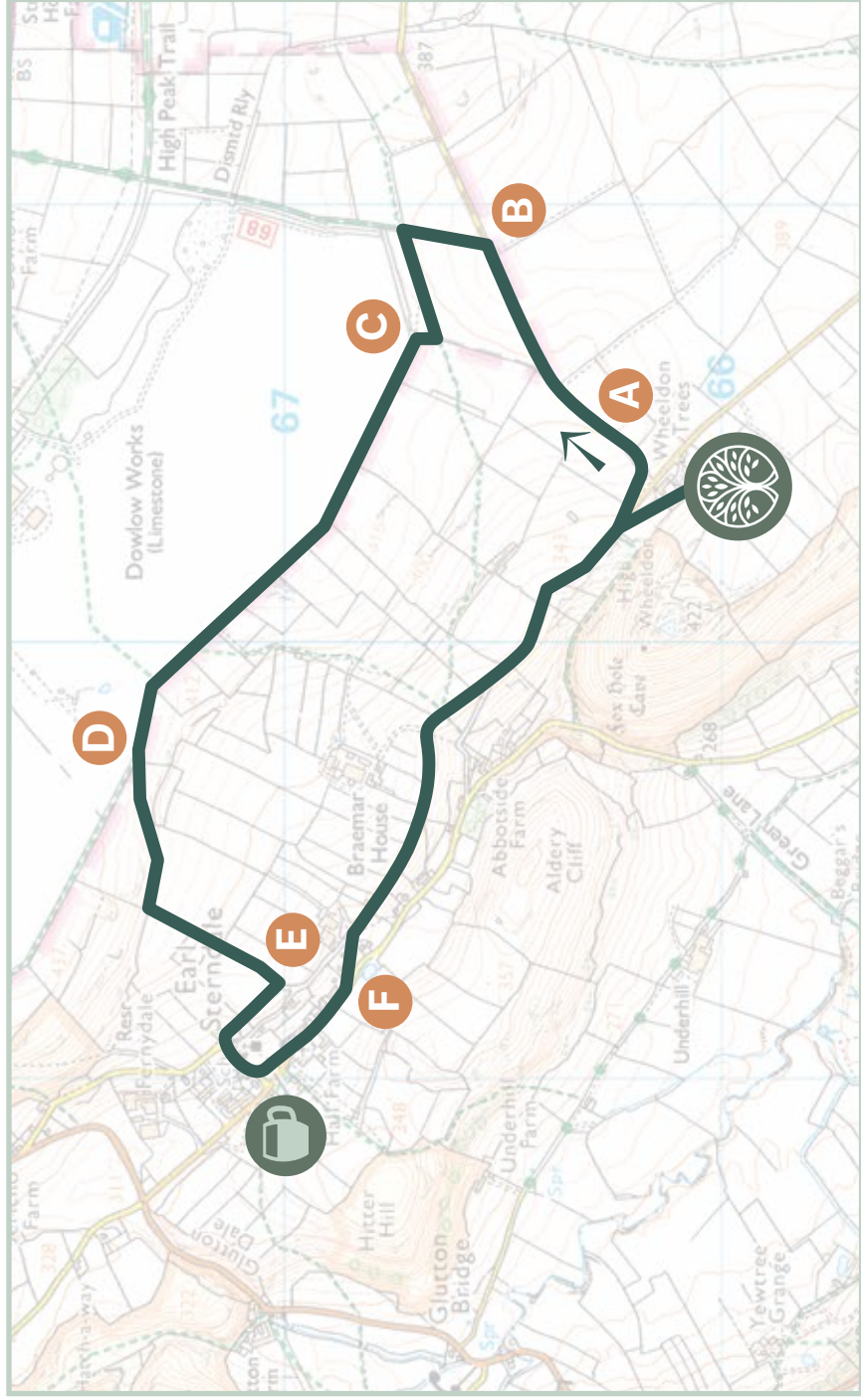
About a mile up the road, on the right,
